

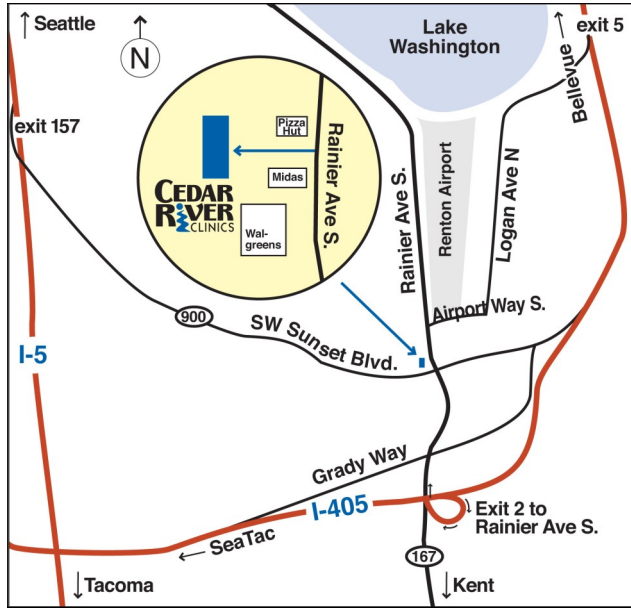

- Pre-Abortion Instructions:**
- 1) When you call for an abortion appointment, plan to spend 10 minutes on the phone. Appointments are available within a few days of your call.
 - 2) Plan to spend 3-4 hours at the clinic for paperwork, ultrasound, lab tests, consent, abortion, and recovery.
 - 3) No alcohol or street drugs for 24 hours before your appointment. No children in the clinic.
 - 4) Photo ID is required for you and anyone coming with you into the clinic.
 - 5) If you need a 2 or 3 day procedure, plan to stay overnight within 30 minutes of the clinic. Local motels offer free shuttles to airport and clinic.
 - 6) If you receive sedation, you cannot drive afterward so arrange for a driver.
 - 7) If you have questions during regular business hours, call the main number (800-572-4223) to talk with a nurse. You may call this same number 24 hours a day in an emergency.
 - 8) Payment is required at your first appointment. We accept DSHS Provider One cards, cash, money order, debit, MasterCard, Visa, and most insurance. No checks.
 - 9) Low-income pregnant women can get free medical care through DSHS. Apply in person at your local DSHS office, or call 800-770-4334 for details.
 - 10) At Cedar River Clinics, WA State residents can sign up for Take Charge to receive one year of free birth control. See Birth-Control-Comparison.info.

The Abortion Pill: Also known as Medical Abortion, Medication Abortion, or Mifeprex, it is an early option as soon as pregnancy is confirmed by ultrasound and up to 8 weeks LMP (since Last Menstrual Period). You take the Mifepristone pill orally during your appointment at the clinic. Then 24 to 72 hours later, you take the Misoprostol pills, as directed, and within 6 to 8 hours, bleeding and cramping begins like in a miscarriage. One to three follow-up appointments are required.

First Trimester: Aspiration procedure is used up to 12 weeks LMP.

Second Trimester Dilation and Extraction (D&E): One-day appointments for 12 weeks to 14 weeks LMP may be available at the doctor's discretion; otherwise from 12 to 22 weeks LMP, appointments are scheduled on two consecutive days. Over 22 weeks LMP requires appointments on 3 consecutive days. Between appointments you must stay overnight within 30 minutes of the clinic.

Special Appointments for Fetal Anomalies: Call to talk with a client support specialist to arrange appointments that meet your needs.

Anesthesia: Optional sedation (anesthesia medication) is administered by a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist or Physician and affects your level of consciousness during the procedure. Options are explained in detail during your appointment. To receive sedation, you must not eat or drink 2-4 hours before your procedure, and you must have someone to drive you home.

Options Counseling: If you are pregnant, unsure and want to explore your options, call to schedule an "Options Counseling" appointment to meet with a specially trained counselor who offers unbiased and nonjudgmental tools for decision-making.

Teens: In Washington, parental involvement is not required for abortion, birth control or STI/HIV testing.

Interpreters: Please request a Certified Medical Interpreter in advance. Written materials available in Korean, Vietnamese, Russian and Spanish.

Walk-In Well-Woman Care: We offer annual exams, pap smears, breast exams, birth control, rapid HIV tests, testing and treatment for urinary tract infections or sexually transmitted diseases.
